- Management Approach to Goal 1: Reduce Fine Sediment, Nitrogen and Phosphorus Loads. Example policies:
 - Policy 1.1. Implement Urban Stormwater Projects and Measures to Reduce Loads of Fine Sediment, Nitrogen and Phosphorus
 - Supporting BMP policies
 - Supporting Road Abrasive / Deicer / Particulate Efficient Sweeping Policy
 - Supporting Unpaved Road Policy
 - Supporting Stream Restoration Policy
 - Other Supporting Policies

TMDL Implementation Subelement Goal 1: Implement Projects and Other Actions to Reduce Loads and Meet the Clarity Challenge

- Policy 1. Maximize Implementation of Urban Stormwater Treatment in accord with Pollutant Reduction Strategy to Meet Load Reductions
 - Alternative Strategy 1.1 and Actions for Urban Runoff Continuation of Current Best Practice
 - Alternative Strategy 1.2 and Actions for Urban Runoff Retrofit and Enhanced Best Practices
 - Alternative Strategy 1.3 and Actions for Urban Runoff Focus on Innovation and Advanced Practices
 - Alternative Strategy 1.4 and Actions for Urban Runoff All Out Push
